


University Of Canterbury

Applications Open For Gateway Work Experience 2025

You can collect an Expression of Interest form from Student Services, or email Paula Willis at wsp@whs.school.nz. All applications will need to be signed by a parent or caregiver.

Gateway work experience is for one day a week for a term/10 weeks or over a school holiday period. Being on Gateway the student will achieve a minimum of 10 to 20 credits on a Health and Safety course and a Work Ready course or Industry-based unit standards.

Gateway is not a timetabled class and successful students will have to catch up on the school work they miss due to the work placement. Students can choose a day that works best for them and that least impacts their school timetable, students must have a high level of attendance at school.

Gateway Opportunity

If you are interested in youth work, other social sectors or simply supporting people in your community, this is the perfect way to begin your journey! This programme runs outside of the classroom setting and is youth-focused, meaning we always aim to work in ways that suit young people in the programme.

The programme runs on Wednesdays in Terms 2 and 3 with the option to continue into Term 4 to complete a full level 3 certificate in youth work. We run two groups, one in Wellington Central, and one in Porirua, so you can choose what option you think will work best for you. Sessions run from 1 pm – 3 pm in Porirua and 4 pm – 6 pm in Wellington Central. You can earn 31 Level 3 credits in youth work in Terms 2 and 3 and additional 14 credits if you continue into Term 4 (45 credits total).

Gateway - IAG Insurance (3 Day Work Placement)

IAG is an international insurance company with a community focus. This 12-credit, Level 3 programme for Year 12 & 13 students is aimed at building independent and creative young minds where you will be exposed to different departments within the company and product and service knowledge. This experience provides a supported work placement opportunity to business-minded learners wanting a taste of the corporate world.
