The University of Otago, Māori Health Workforce Development Unit is pleased to inform you that applications for the **Otago REACH (Realising Educational Aspirations for Careers in Health)** This scholarship is for Year 13 Māori secondary students interested in a career in health and is hosted by the University of Otago. The Scholarship covers; flights, accommodation, food, and activities over 3 days.

The main requirement is that students have aspirations for a career in health. Studying science subjects at levels 2 and 3, and their involvement or interest in Te Ao Māori will strengthen their application however we strongly encourage all students with aspirations in health.

The REACH Otago Scholarship provides opportunities for up to twenty Year 13 Māori students to spend three nights and days on the University of Otago's Dunedin campus. Students from across New Zealand experience university life first-hand: living in, and visiting, residential colleges; attending lectures; meeting current Otago students; and learning about the various degree and study options Otago offers, particularly in health.

Upcoming Fully Funded Outward Bound Courses for students with disabilities

Enrollments are now open for the following Outward Bound courses for secondary school students with disabilities. Places are filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

These courses are fully funded. The only cost to students is getting a pre-course medical done by a GP and getting themselves to and from Picton where the courses start and finish. Our Adapted courses are from 6-8 days and are based in the Marlborough Sounds. Students build confidence, and independence, and make new friends through activities such as sailing, waka ama, ropes course, and camping.
