What is a High School Exchange?

On a high school exchange, you live in another country for a chosen period, during which you attend a local high school and live with a host family.

You must be between <u>15 and 18 years old to be eligible for an exchange</u>. The time you will be away can be anything from four weeks to a year. You live your normal life like how you would here in New Zealand - you go to school, catch up with friends and help keep your room tidy (right?). Except in the case of student exchange you do all of this in another country - learning about a new culture and possibly even a new language, living with a new family and hanging out with new friends.
