

Year 10 Subject Selection FAQs

If I don't do a course in Year 10, can I take that course in Year 11?

Yes, apart from languages and music. If you want to do a language or music in Year 11 you must take it in Year 10.

Can I only take a language for half a year?

No, you must take it for a full year.

I want to do a language, but I also want to do 1 option from Option Line 1 and 1 option from Option Line 2. Can I do this?

If the language you want to do is Japanese, Māori or Spanish you can, as those languages are in both lines. You just need to make sure you pick the language once for Terms 1 & 2 and once for Terms 3 & 4. So if you wanted to do 10ANI, 10CLS and 10SPA you could select 10SPA for Terms 1&2, and 10ANI for Terms 3&4 in Option Line 1, and 10CLS for Terms 1&2, and 10SPA for Terms 3&4 in Option Line 2.

I've heard that I can do either Māori Performing Arts (MPA) or Performance (PER) for the whole year. Is this true?

Yes it is. These courses are either half year or whole year courses. This is because there are multiple year levels who will be doing them as well, so they follow a full year program - i.e. each half is different - it doesn't repeat.

I want to do 3 options from Option Line 1 and only 1 from Option Line 2. What do I do?

You'll need to indicate that you have a clash. To do this you need to decide which of the 3 options you want to do on Option Line 1 are your top 2, and put these in the form. In Option Line 2 put in the option you want to do in either Term 1&2 or Term 3&4. Leave the other slot in Option Line 2 blank to indicate you have a clash (it's the choice right at the top). Then in the final question note down the subject you want to do from Option Line 1 but can't.

Do I really need to get my parent or caregiver to sign the paper form? Isn't just using the Google Form enough?

Yes, your parent/caregiver needs to sign the form and you need to return that to your rōpū teacher by the end of Monday next week (Sept 16).
